Visa Application Itinerary & Document Checklist

Overview

Tourist visas are for people travelling for leisure, visiting friends or family, or short sightseeing trips — not for paid work in the destination country.

Consulates look for a clear travel purpose, realistic itinerary, proof you can pay for the trip, and evidence you intend to return home (employment, studies, property, or family ties). Requirements vary widely by nationality and destination.

Visa Details

Typical use	Leisure, tourism, short family visits
Processing	Varies by destination; we advise after profile review
Entry pattern	Single or multiple entry — as per embassy rules for your nationality

Required Documents

- Typical documents: passport, application form, photos, bank statements, hotel or host details, return tickets where required.
- We help you avoid weak or inconsistent dates, generic itineraries, and bank statements that do not match your story.
- If you need a sponsor or invitation letter, we review wording so it supports — not contradicts — your application.

Application Process

1. You share travel dates, passport nationality, and a rough itinerary.
2. We send a tailored checklist and sample formats for cover letters and bookings.

4. We guide you through payment of official fees and submission or appointment steps.
5. You receive updates when the embassy or VFS moves your file — we help interpret requests for extra documents.
